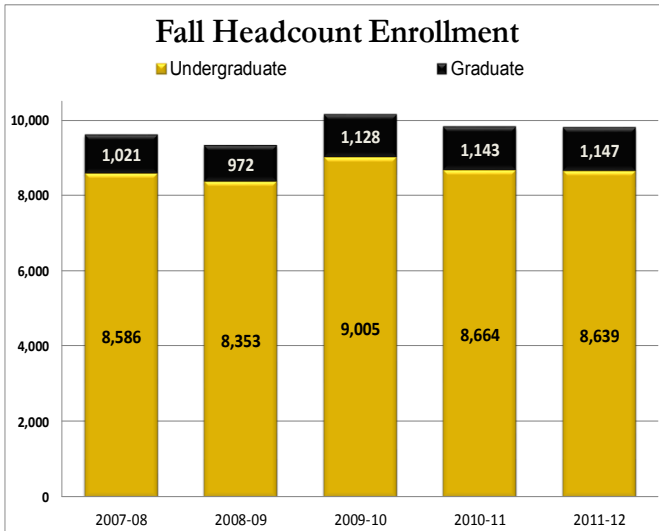

Tuition and Fees for Academic Year

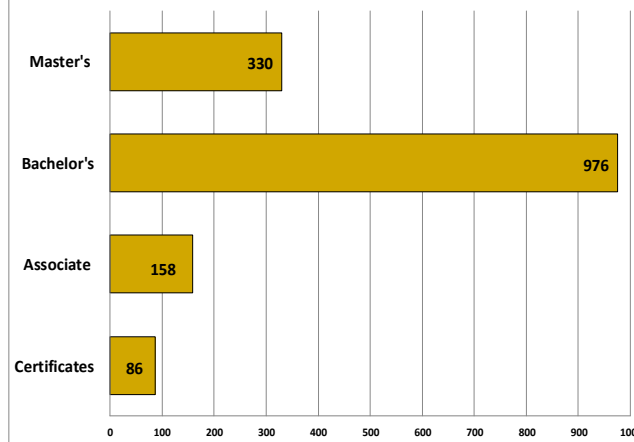

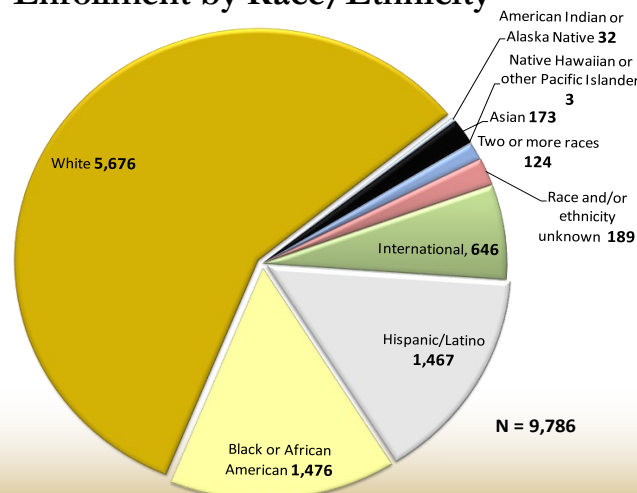
Degrees Awarded: July 1, 2010 - June 30, 2011

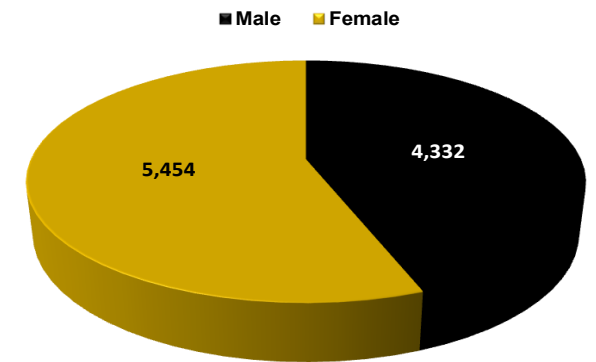
Enrollment by Race/Ethnicity
